The Catholic Church, also known as the Roman Catholic Church, is the largest Christian denomination. The Virgin Mary is venerated in the Catholic Church as Mother of God and Queen of Heaven, honoured in dogmas and devotions. Its teaching includes the Counter-Reformation (Latin: *Contrareformatio*), also called the Catholic Reformation (Latin: *Reformatio*). The two distinct dogmatic positions within the Catholic Church solidified in the 16th century. The Catholic Reformation became known as the Counter-Reformation. However, the term Catholic with a capital C also applies in common parlance to the Churches within the Catholic Communion, centered in Rome. The Church.
